JANUARY 3

Cloudy, not cold.
Went to Carlson's for
treatment at 10:30.
Wrote to Dave P. m.
Ruth Hahn called.
Mary & I. Wallace in.
Slosh got his notice
today — the 14th.

JANUARY 4

Cloudy damp day.
went to Carlsbad again.
Can't see any improvement
except in how I feel.
Rachel over P.M.

Ruth & don to B. B game
dad to store to kill chickens
eve.

Bob arrived at
11:30 tonight looking
wonderful. He came
into P. S. Sun. night
— to Camp Kilmer — to
Indian town gap & so
home — discharged.

JANUARY 5

A Beautiful sun shining
warm (70°) day. It's
a wonderful day.
I got up at 8:30 —
cause Bob was up &
feel I must see if
he was really here or
I'd been dreaming last
night. Hey real & so
good to look at. Grandma
was really surprised.
We sat around & talked
most of the day. Dad
came home at 3:30.
Don went down to the
store for him. (Mrs.
(Ann) Bonne & Grandma C.)
were up awhile tonight.

JANUARY 6

Another warm day.
Sunny part of the day
& misted rain around
noon. I got up around
noon - feel some
better today. Bob
opened his Chr. gifts
today, so I guess Christmas
is over & we'll take the
tree down tomorrow.

Bob tried some of his
civvies on - some are
pretty tight! Nic heavy.
170^{lb}. Many in this P.M.
Maurice up tonight.

JANUARY 7

Rainy & cloudy all day.
Mother washed.
Ruth stand home q. sp.
with a cold. Dad, Ron
& Bob went in town P.M.
shopping for 'civvies'
for Bob. He got a suit,
tie, 2 shirts, 2 pr. shoes,
& socks. Bob was calling
on needs - Holmes taking up.
Dad went to Pro BB
game.

Dave called tonight
ab 9. & then cause Bob
wasn't here then, he called
back ab 11. He going to
try to get home this weekend.

JANUARY 8

Cloudy day. Warm.
I came down about 10.
Grandma ironed. I got
lunch & made a pie
& jello P.M. Flea had
to rest. can't be on my
feet much. Crocheted on
Ruth's gloves eve. Packed
some eggs & soap ships
for Betty & a bag for
Gene. Bob put juicers

early & got up at 2 a.m.
cause we expected Dave
in then. Don & Bob met
the train but he wasn't
on it so we went to bed
& when Dad got up at
6 a.m. he had just come
so every one got up then.
So now I have 3 boys
(men) here at once.
They're playing cards
with dad sometime.

JANUARY 28

Sunny
Got 3 letters from Betty
& the announcement card.
She's O.K. & says Jr. is
being called Bates' Cancer
he's too big.
Also letters from Dave
& Don.

Have had toothache since
noon. Had to get up
at 2 p.m. to doctor it!

JANUARY 29

Sunny all day and not
cold. Snow nearly all
gone. Washed kit.
Windows & put up clean
curtains a.m. Took
treatment at 1:30. My
face is swollen with
tooth ache - still got

in a few minutes -

went down to grandma.
She not feeling good. Not
coming up to work any more,
I guess.

went to Poland-Spring game
tonight. very good game
& we won 35 to 27.

FEBRUARY 22

more snow. Cloudy.
Washed & ironed & pack
up curtains in dining
room today besides
'helping' clean the up-
stairs.

Bob & Bob married this
evening & we played
500. Their cute and
fun to have around.
Dane went down to
St. Legion Hall with Fred
Marie to sit in with
an orchestra there that
Fred is in.
